Regulation

3MG PhD mobility grants





1) Eligibility

- The PhD student concerned must be registered at Nantes Université, IMT Atlantique or Université Gustave Eiffel in the Graduate School Matter, Molecules, Materials and Geosciences (3MG).
- Mobility grants can be awarded for the following participations:
 - o Training schools (summer/winter schools...)
 - o Training courses in a foreign university
 - o Current or future scientific collaborations with a foreign laboratory
 - o Immersion training in a foreign laboratory
- Travel to the partner laboratory is not eligible for a thesis in co-supervision.

2) Financial support

- A maximum grant is offered depending of the destination:
 - o €350 in France
 - €500 in Europe (including UK)
 - o €800 outside Europe
- A co-funding from the home research unit or the host institution is recommended, but not mandatory.
- The same PhD student cannot benefit from more than one support during the year.
- Funding is not guaranteed and will depend on available budget. A PhD student who has already benefited from a support in the past will not be priority.

3) Calendar

- The mobility must be carried out before December 31, 2025.
- Applications will be reviewed by the operational committee of the Graduate School. In order to be
 presented to the committee, applications must be submitted by the following dates:
 - o March 21
 - o May 12
 - o June 25
 - An additional slot could be proposed depending of the available budget
- The applicant and the research unit will receive a response within 10 days after the dates mentioned above.

4) Payment of the grant

- The grant can be paid to the home research unit or directly to the PhD student, depending of the financial plan.
- To trigger the payment, the following documents must be presented:
 - Copy of transport tickets

- For scientific collaborations or immersion training: letter of invitation OR certificate of attendance signed by the host institution
- For training schools or training courses: certificate of registration OR certificate of attendance signed by the host institution
- At the end of the stay, applicants will have to send a short report describing the benefits of the mobility (1 page max).

5) Application

- The application file available on the website of the Graduate School 3MG must be completed and signed by the PhD student, the thesis director and the director of the research unit.
